

discussion book is "*Where the Crawdads Sing*" by Delia Owens. We always welcome new members. Come even if you have not read the book.

"Where the Crawdads Sing," is a #1 New York Times bestseller by wildlife scientist and nature writer Delia Owens.

When she was six years old, Kya's mother abandoned her and her siblings. Eventually deserted by her father and siblings, Kya learns to live by herself. She is taunted as a swamp rat and retreats from interaction with the community around her. Nature becomes her source of solace and sustenance. Kya becomes fascinated with wildlife and nature including insects, birds, dappled light, the marshes' shifting tides. She has a collection of feathers and shells and explores the wetlands and its feathered residents. She is drawn to two men as she yearns for love and connection. She opens herself to this new experience and the unexpected happens. Meanwhile, the police start looking for the killer of Chase Andrews.
